

Undergraduate Application Checklist for International Students

Florida National University asks you to please use this checklist to ensure that your application is complete before you submit it.

Academic Requirements:

- Completed high school- Diploma
- Academic transcript(s) must be official, translated to English.
- Must have U.S.A. Academic Credential Equivalency by an official credential company (Ex: WES, ECE, Spantran, Etc.) Document-by-Document Evaluation
- □ Foreign school must be accredited by the Ministry of Education of the country or a USA accrediting commission.
- Original test scores (If it applies).
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (the TOEFL) and obtain a score of 500 or higher on the paper based version or 62 or higher on the internet-based version or a score of 5.5 on the IELTS.

I-20 visa Requirements:

- □ Documented evidence of means of financial support must be provided to FNU for admission purposes and for issuance of the Certificate of Eligibility (1-20-M-N) form → Bank letter, statements, showing balance is US Dollars.
- Copy of Passport.
- International students must have funds available for paying fees when they register for their classes each semester.
- Once admitted you must pay registration fee \$250.00 (Non-refundable).
- Students must arrive in the USA a week prior to the start date.
