MHSA Application Checklist for International Students

Florida National University asks you to please use this checklist to ensure that your application is complete before you submit it.

Academic Requirements:

- Complete a Graduate Program application (You can obtain it from our website).
- Academic transcript(s) must be official, translated to English.
- Must have **U.S.A. Academic Credential Equivalency** by an official credential company (Ex: WES, ECE, Spantran, Etc.)
- Foreign school must be accredited by the Ministry of Education of the country or a USA accrediting commission.
- Original test scores (If it applies).
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (the TOEFL) and obtain a score of 500 or higher on the paper based version or 62 or higher on the internet-based version or a score of 5.5 on the IELTS.
- If undergraduate GPA is less than 2.50, a GMAT score of 400 and above or a GRE score of 900 and above is required. (Sent by PearsonVue or ETS).
- Admissions Essay.
- Have computer skills knowledge (Microsoft Office: Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.)
- Two letters of recommendations.
- Resume.
- Interview through video conference.

I-20 visa Requirements:

- Documented evidence of means of financial support must be provided to FNU for admission purposes and for issuance of the Certificate of Eligibility (I-20-M-N) form → Bank letter, statements, showing balance is US Dollars.
- Copy of Passport.
- International students must have funds available for paying fees when they register for their classes each semester.
- Once admitted you must pay registration fee \$150.00 (Non-refundable).
- Students must arrive in the USA a week prior to the start date.
